

FIU College Impact Fall 2020 Program

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The FIU College Impact Program is designed to provide extended learning and enrichment opportunities to students and parents at Miami Central.

The after school component will offer planned activities including PSAT/SAT Prep, academic tutoring, college planning, and career workshops.

STUDENTS:

The program will be open to all students at Miami Central Senior High School. However, each target school will host 15 students representing each level, 9th through 12th grades. Students will be required to commit to a minimum of one academic term.

This is a free program, however, it is available on a first come, first serve basis. Once students finish the program, they will receive a Certificate of Completion for the FIU College Impact Program. This also comes with opportunities for scholarship recognition.

Our programs are embedded with weekly incentives to encourage participants' engagement. Students will also have access to their own personalized SAT & College Preparation accounts and resources through graduation. Another added feature of our program is that students will have direct access and contact with experts and professionals in various career fields.
